MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON
OCTOBER 8, 2017

Bob Galloway opened the meeting with a prayer.

Bob gave the treasurer's report showing a balance of \$3,286.38. There were three expenditures during the month, one in the amount of \$201.14 for food from Sam's for the previous pancake breakfast, one in the amount of \$77.10 for sausage for the previous pancake breakfast, and one in the amount of \$148.73 for a hand truck requested by Fr. John.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as presented.

Bob reported that he had purchased the hand truck and brought it to the church as requested.

Bob also reported that he and Moon had painted the music closet and installed a door on it.

Bob reminded us that half of the profits from the previous pancake breakfast, as well as from future pancake breakfasts, will be going to the Tithe Fund.

A request that was made from the office to install blackout shades in the gym was discussed and placed on hold because of the energy committee's intention to replace those windows and the shades may not fit after such installation.

Bill reported that the fluorescent lights on the first floor (except the parish hall kitchen) have been converted to LEDs and we still have more work to do on the second floor as well as working on some of the incandescent type lighting in the parish hall.

Bill moved that Bob Galloway be reimbursed the amount of \$81.39 for shelving that had put in the music closet. Tommy seconded. Motion carried.

Bob moved that Bill Frame be reimbursed \$38.52 for an emergency light in the parish hall kitchen. John Providenti seconded. Motion carried.

Next pancake breakfast will be October 22. Bob will be responsible for getting the food.

Jack Dever moved the meeting be adjourned. John Dever seconded. Motion carried.
