- Budget Review – Carla Stricker and Natalie Zellers
    - Financially sound, growing endowments,
      - Fr. Leon Endowment fund has interest available for capital use in 2025
    - Finance council approves ring camera for safety for office work
    - Faith formation - there will be an increased expense due to confirmation class
    - Youth Activity - travel to NCYC in Indianapolis- hopefully be paid for from Camp Leon profit
    - Maintenance budget has decreased by \$20,000 - unknown cause of decrease in expense, Natalie will get back to Council
    - Possible 2025 capital projects - planned to use grants
      - - new roof over parish hall with solar panels
    - Net Income at the end of 2024 is due to the Fr. Paul's grant writing
  - Small Group Ministry Update – Molly Belcher
    - Difficulty to reserve space in Park Towers
    - Home Church has been rescheduled to January 9th or 10th
    - Home Church will start off the small group Faith Sharing
      - Ted Streit will be taking the lead on Small Group Faith Sharing
